I'd like to welcome you to what will be another impactful year at Elyria High School. As a proud alumna and the principal of Elyria High School, I am excited to begin what will be an amazing year of growth for your child. I have spent the last 15 years in Elyria City Schools and have a heart for the students and families in this community.

Elyria Schools follow the P.B.I.S. framework with the expectations for students to **“Be Ready.... Be Responsible.... Be Respectful”**. Our teachers' classroom management plans will clearly state expected behaviors in positive and easy to understand terms. We have identified specific strategies the staff will demonstrate, model and practice with students to create the best learning environment possible. These techniques and strategies will be implemented building-wide, even in courses that require additional rules and procedures to ensure student safety. With our P.B.I.S. efforts, you can expect for your child to be challenged with high expectations that will drive them to become stronger academically, behaviorally and socially while being surrounded and supported by adults that have your child's best interest and future in mind.

Every student is receiving this informational packet to ensure a successful start to the 2023-2024 school year at Elyria High School. I am asking you to review the packet materials with your student/parent to become familiar with the procedures at E.H.S. The packet contains general building information, important dates, and helpful information for students and parents as we continue to integrate our Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (P.B.I.S.) within the building, our classrooms, and everyone's daily interactions with each other. With over 160 course offerings, 125 teachers providing instruction across 11 content areas and using a small school model, we continue to identify focus areas to concentrate on which we believe will strengthen our students' academic success and provide them with a more positive learning environment.

Elyria High students will also receive a school-issued Chromebook at the beginning of the year and every teacher maintains a Google Classroom for student and parent accessibility. It also provides multiple ways for parents and students to communicate and stay connected with school.

Your partnership in your child's academic journey is a priority for Elyria High School. This year, you will be receiving a monthly newsletter titled ***“The Pioneer Journey”***. This newsletter is specific to the Elyria High School and will highlight what has been happening and keep you abreast to current details and aspects within the high school. Please find it as a resource and a way of staying connected to your child's experience.

I look forward to seeing you on the first day of school, Monday, August 21st. ## **Highlighted Guidelines and Information:**

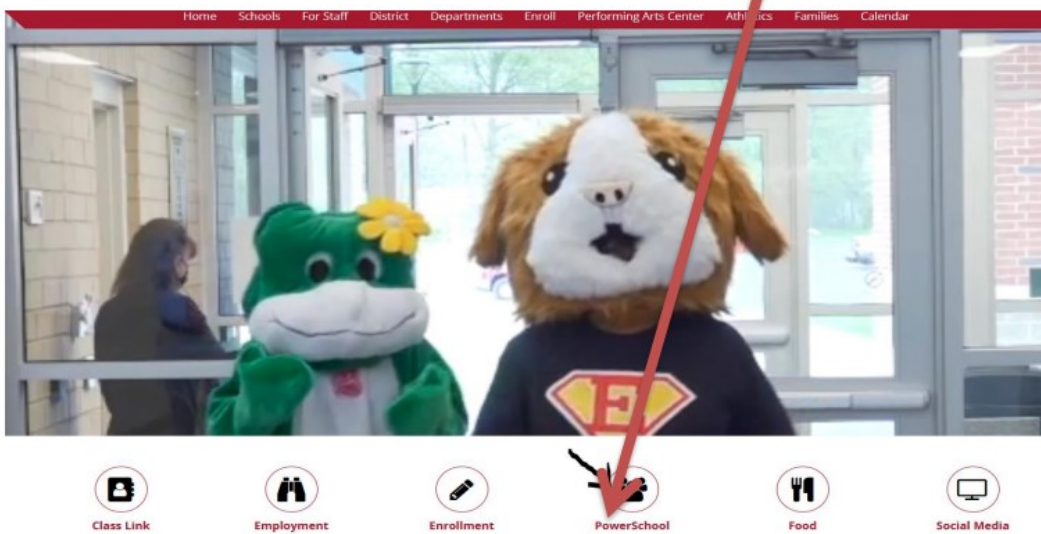
- **Required Forms:** ALL parents are required to complete an emergency medical, internet agreement and drug/alcohol agreement forms which are available on-line at the link below. These important forms must be submitted electronically by Tuesday, September 15, 2023.  
Visit <https://ps-elyr.metasolutions.net/public/> and sign in to your PowerSchool Parent Portal.
- **Master Schedule/Student Times:** The school day begins at 7:50 AM and will end at 2:39 PM. The school building will be open at 7:35 AM for students. ALL students who arrive prior to 7:50 AM will report to the dining hall where a to-go breakfast will be available. Students will not be permitted to enter any other part of the high school until 7:35 AM. Students will continue to have five minutes for travel time between classes with a warning bell sounding one minute before the start of class. Homeroom period will continue to be part of the 2<sup>nd</sup> period class (8:41 AM to 8:48 AM – beginning of period).
- **Student Schedules/ First Day:** Enclosed is your tentative schedule for the 2023-2024 school year. If you have any questions about your schedule, please contact your guidance counselor. Students will receive an updated schedule in their homeroom on the first day of school. All students will follow the Regular Bell Schedule on the first day of school which is included in this packet.
- **Team/ Office Locations:** Please see the enclosed directory guide for team office locations, team phone numbers, principal/counselor assignments and main office information. Please Note: Team 2 & 4 first floor, Team 1 & 3 second floor.
- **Arrival Entrance for Students:** Students entering the building from West Avenue (student parking lot) will need to enter the building using Door: N which is located through the archway leading into the dining hall. Please see enclosed aerial map for specific details on visitor entrance, parking locations, student entrances and student drop-off/ pickup locations.
- **Visitors:** All visitors to Elyria High School must report to the main office through the main office entrance (Door: A) located off Middle Avenue near the flag poles. The main office is open from 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM.
- **School Attire:** ALL students will be required to follow the Elyria Schools dress code beginning with the first day of school. The dress code is included in the [August E.H.S. Newsletter](#) as well as in this packet.
- **Cell Phones:** Students may bring their cell phones to school but they must be turned off and put away during the day unless they are used as a part of a teacher-directed lesson in class. Same rules apply to Bluetooth headphones--they may not be worn during the school day. The Elyria Schools are not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged electronic devices.
- **ID Guidelines:** ALL students will receive a school issued ID. The wearing of school ID's will be required each school day to ensure the safety of all students and staff. The Elyria High School student ID guidelines are included in the packet.
- **Lockers & Locks:** All students will receive their locker assignment and lock on the first day of school in homerooms.
- **Open House:** On Thursday, August 31, 2023, the staff at EHS will conduct an open house from 6:00 PM until 7:00 PM. Parents/guests are free to visit their student's teachers and tour the building. Please free feel to contact your child's team office with any questions.

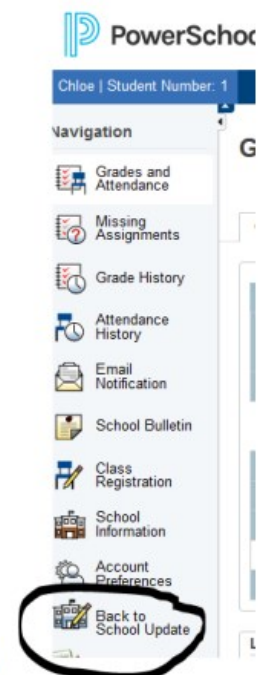

- ◆ Due to the large number of requests for schedule changes, priority will be given to incorrect core subject issues and holes in schedules.

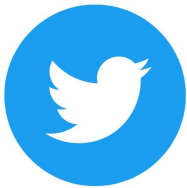

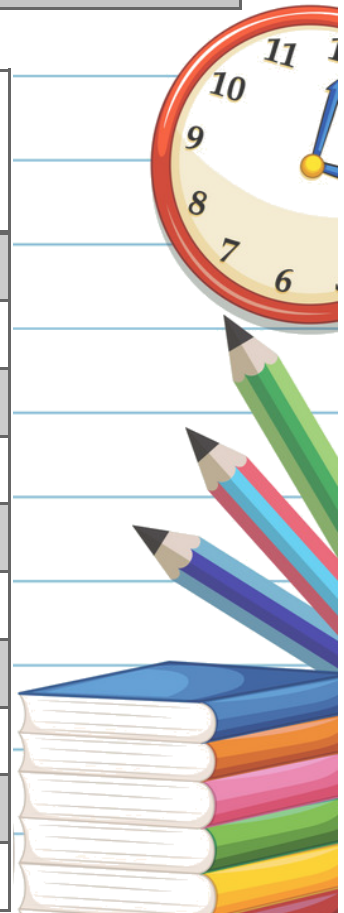

# STUDENT ID

Elyria High School promotes a safe environment for our educational community. Proper identification of all students and staff members is essential to ensure that all persons on campus are approved to be in our school. The student identification (ID) card is required for students to participate in many school sponsored activities. Students must comply with the following ID policy:

Students will receive a new, free of charge, official school identification (ID) card at the beginning of each school year.

Students must report a lost or stolen ID and obtain a replacement immediately for the cost of \$5.00. In order for a student to obtain an ID the assigned teacher will email the media center and a student aid will deliver the students ID card and the student will be required to pay \$5.00 for the replacement ID or sign an obligation card.

All staff and students must have ID cards visible at all times while in school or when participating in any school-sponsored activity.

Students may be asked to show their ID to access areas within the building that specifically require identification.

Students must have their own ID cards (sharing ID cards is not allowed). Any student in possession of a Student ID Card, Home Lunch ID, Late Arrival or Early Dismissal that does not belong to the student will be subject to disciplinary action by a Team Administrator.

Any infractions of Student ID violation will be dealt with by the assigned classroom teacher's Classroom Management Plan. The next step will result in the Team Administrator imposing disciplinary action.

Students with unpaid balances equaling \$15.00 dollars or more may be subject to not attending school sponsored activities/events.

Loss of privileges within the building i.e. the HUB, Rathskeller, Late Arrival, and Early Dismissal.

Any student who has multiple ID infractions may be subject to consequences determined by a Team Administrator.





## School attire and cell phones

Hoodies, and similar tops or jackets with hoods, are "fan favorites" when it comes to school attire. We like them, too, but not when they are worn up and over the head during the school day.

The district's Student Code of Conduct provides direction on headgear, stating that it may not be worn over a person's head or scalp (excluding headgear that's worn for religious or medical reasons.) Hoods can make it difficult to identify an individual in an emergency, and they can also be a distraction in class. Please remind students that hoods may not be worn up during the school day.

The Student Code of Conduct also offers guidance on attire. Clothing must be school appropriate and may not present a health or safety hazard or disrupt the educational environment. Pants and tops must fit properly and be in good repair; crop tops are not permitted.

Additionally, footwear must be school appropriate--slippers and slipper socks are not permitted. Blankets also may not be worn in school.

### EHS EXPECTATION FOCUS- APPROPRIATE SCHOOL ATTIRE

The school attire expectations for the district can be referenced in Section 16 of the Student Code of Conduct. As a district expectation, students at Elyria High School will be expected to adhere to the additional attire requirements:

- **Hoodies may be worn but hoods must be down off of the head while in school.**
- **Crop tops are not permitted.**
- **Pants and tops must fit properly and be in good repair.**
- **Slippers and slipper socks are not permitted.**
- **Blankets may not be worn in school.**

### EHS EXPECTATION FOCUS- CELL PHONES



Students may bring their cell phones to school but they must be turned off and put away during the day unless they are used as a part of a teacher-directed lesson in class. Same rules apply to Bluetooth headphones--they may not be worn during the school day.

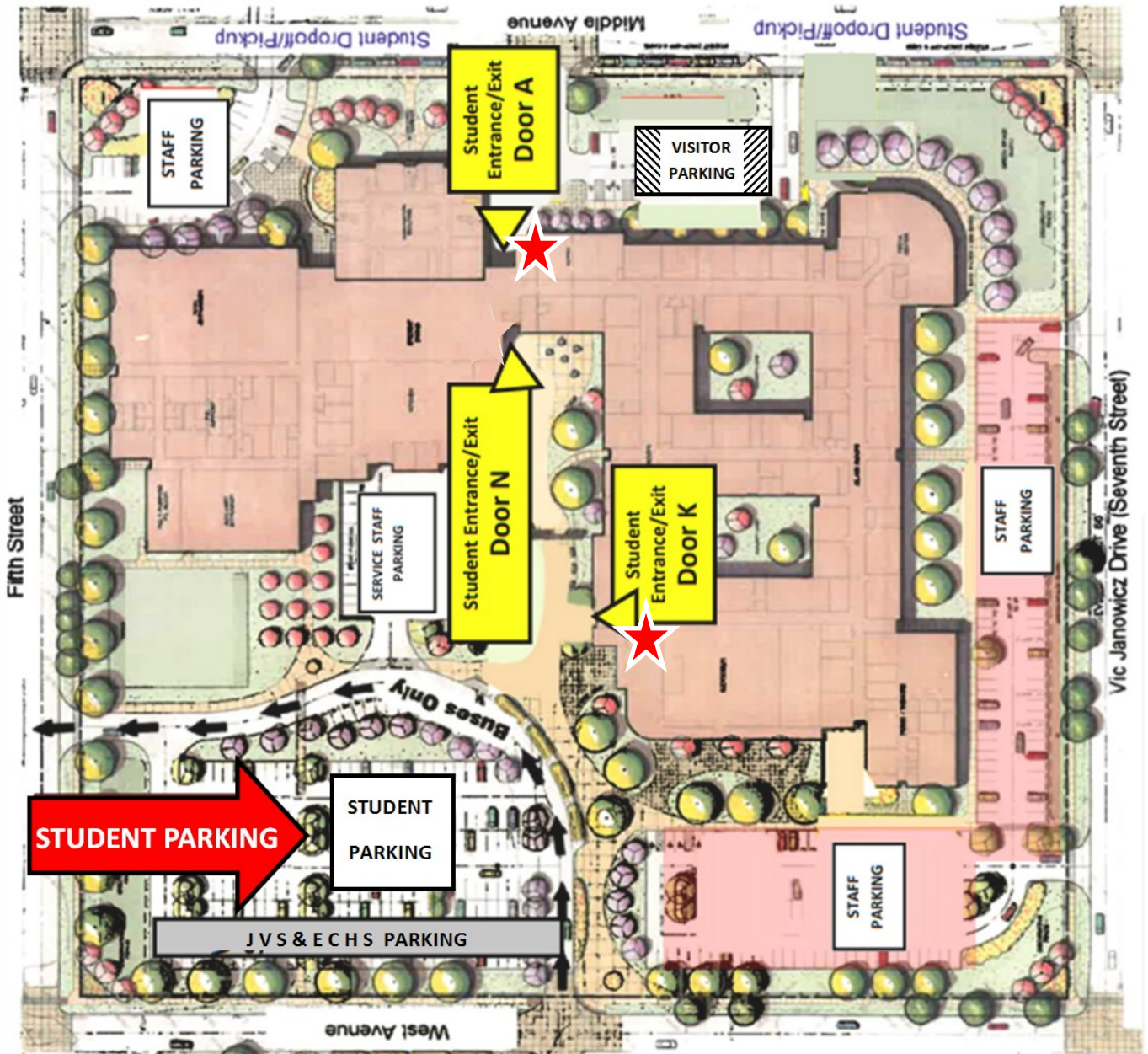

### **ELYRIA HIGH SCHOOL – New School Year REMINDERS**

#### **MEDICATION NEEDED DURING SCHOOL HOURS OR AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES (SPORTS & CLUBS):**

Remember, if your child needs any medications during the school day or school related activities during the school year, including all over-the counter (OTC) medications (for headaches/cramping/pain), physician prescribed medication (MAR), self-carry meds (inhalers, Epi-pen), or diabetic supplies a medication authorization form must be completed and signed by parent/guardian AND physician (MAR only). In addition, the medication must be brought to school in the original labeled container by the parent at the beginning of the school year. You can drop off medication after August 15th at the high school.

WE NEED NEW COMPLETED FORMS EVERY YEAR. Form is available on Elyria Schools website under Pupil Services > Student Health > Documents > Medication Administration Record (MAR) OR OTC medication form

#### **DIABETIC – ASTHMATIC – EPI PEN USERS:**

Even if your child carries their own medications (Inhalers/Epi Pens) or/and glucometer and supplies, physician orders and plan of care is still needed for emergencies. Extra medications and supplies should be kept in the clinic. WE NEED NEW COMPLETED FORMS EVERY YEAR.

#### **MEDICATION FORMS AND CARE PLANS (diabetics, asthma, food/insect allergies, seizures):**

Available online on our website under Pupil Services - *One form per medication*, make copies as needed. Some of the forms can be filled out online and emailed to me. OTC medication form is for over the counter medications like Tylenol, Advil, Midol, etc. Medication Administration Form (MAR) or physician form is for ANY medication prescribed by a doctor/healthcare provider (Insulin, Epipen, Inhaler, seizure medication, etc.)

#### **IMMUNIZATIONS 2023-2024:**

12<sup>th</sup> graders **MUST** have the Meningococcal Vaccine Booster or will be **excluded unexcused** from school. I will be checking immunization records for ALL students. 9-12<sup>th</sup> grade students missing any vaccines may be excluded also after Sept. 7<sup>TH</sup> per Ohio Law.

Please return all forms prior to the first day of school. You are welcome to email them to me or drop them off at the main office.

Thank you for your cooperation in maintaining a healthy and safe environment for our students. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the high school nurse.
